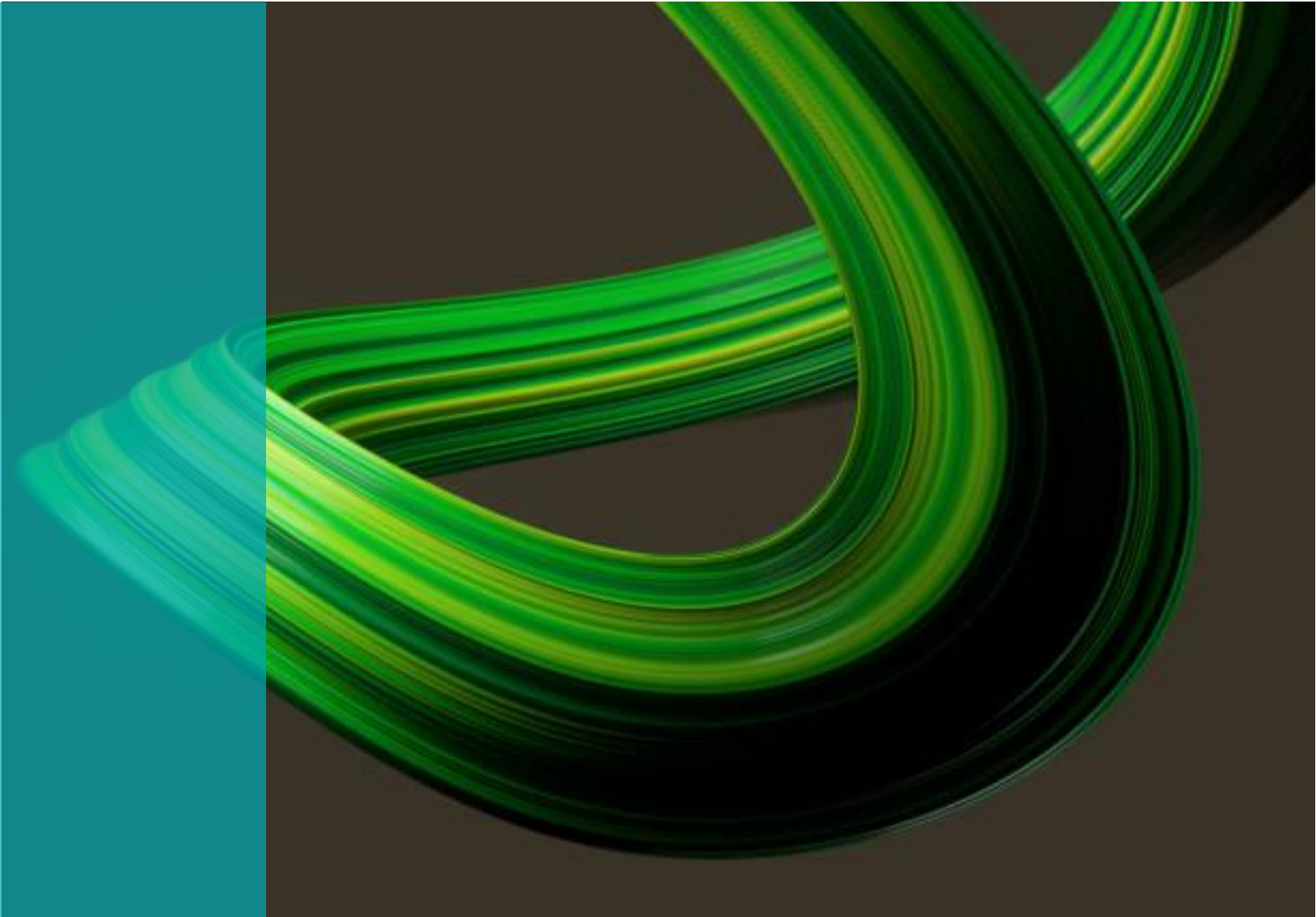

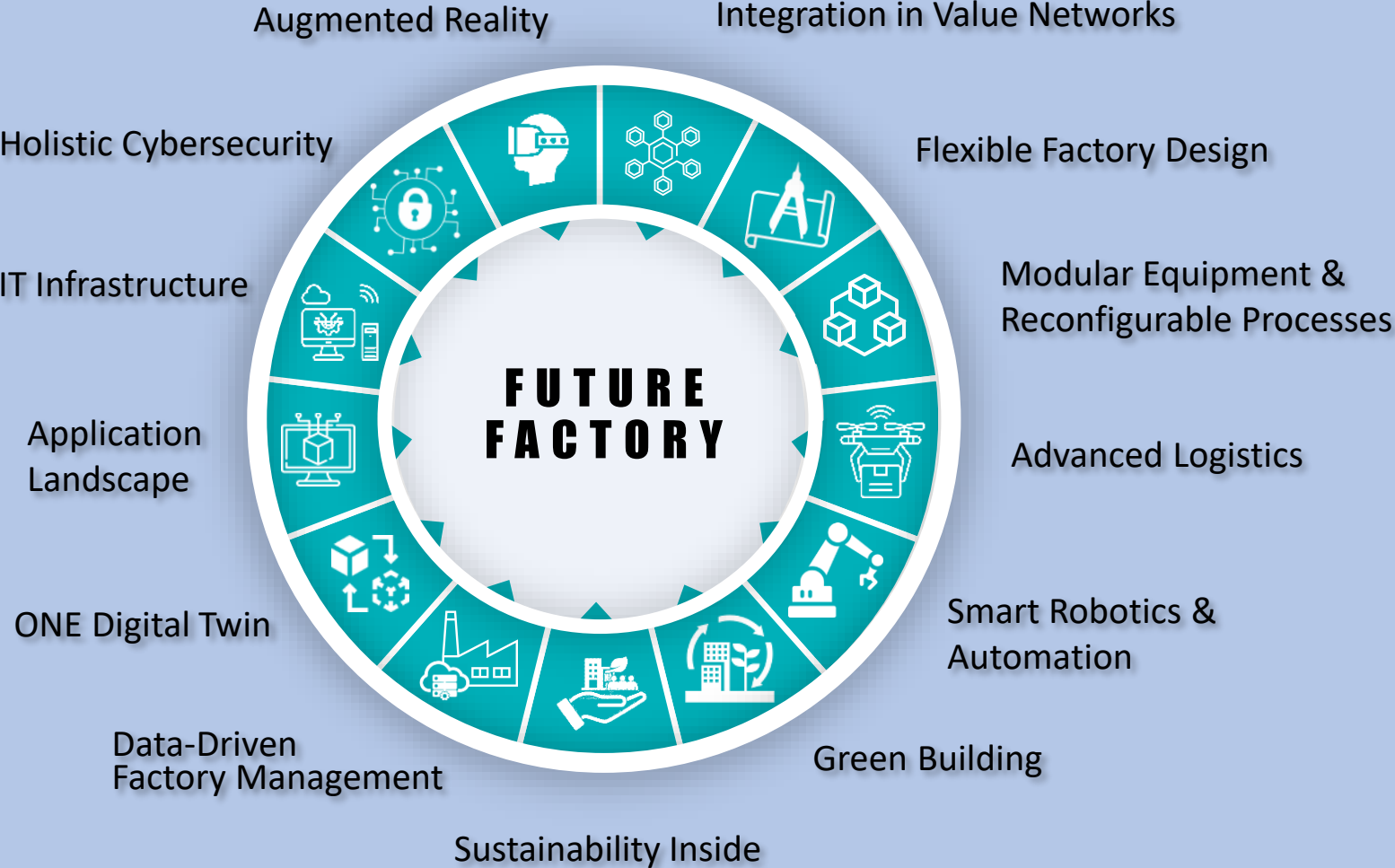
# FUTURE FACTORY

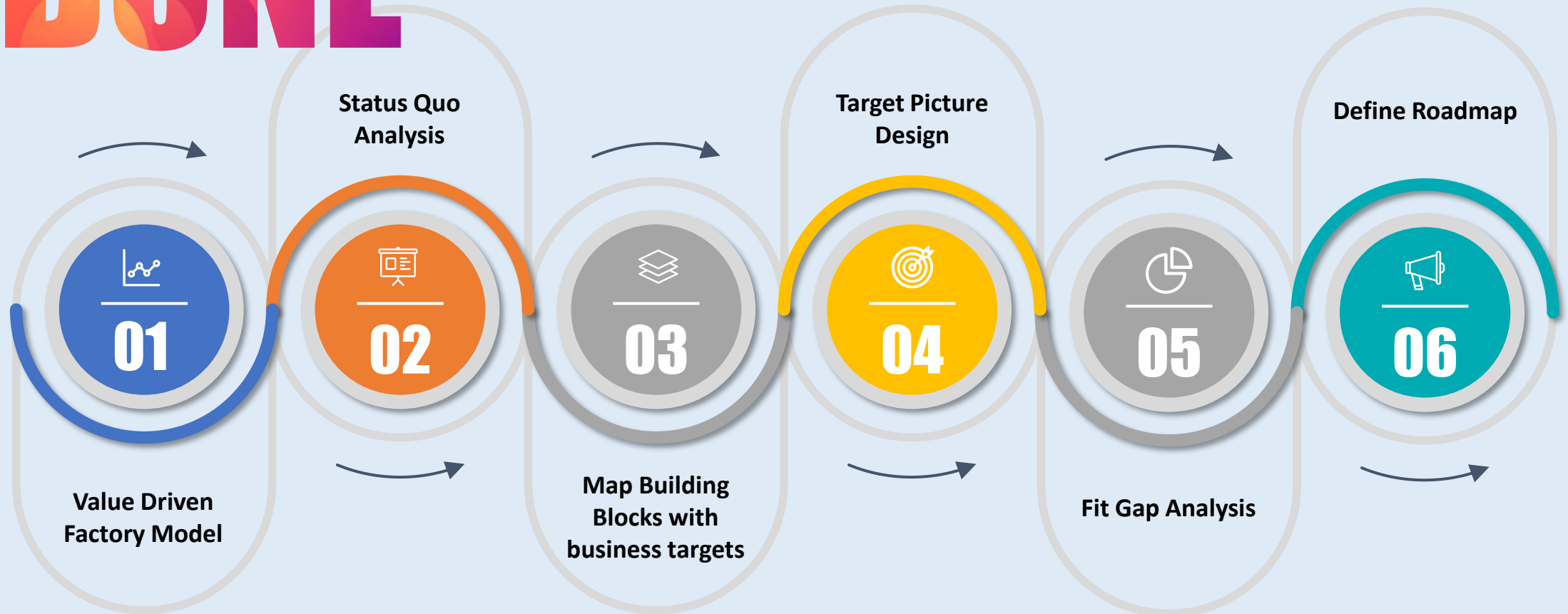

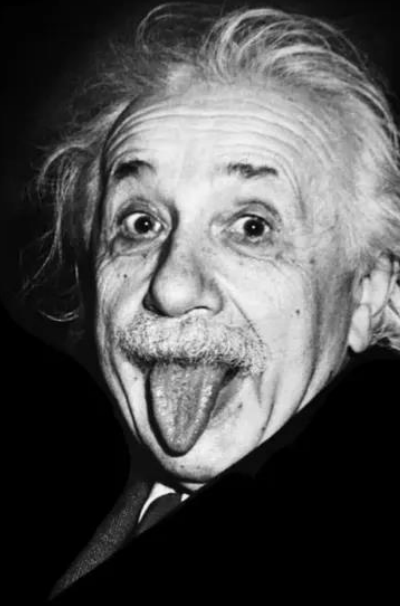
